SUBJECT: MOTION TO WAIVE FURTHER READING AND INTRODUCTION OF REVISED ORDINANCE 2006-217, REGULATING SECOND HAND SMOKE IN THE CITY OF CALABASAS.

MEETING DATE: FEBRUARY 1, 2006

SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the City Council waive full reading and introduce revised Ordinance 2006-217 which regulates second hand smoke in the City of Calabasas. Staff does not recommend second reading of the ordinance introduced at the January 18, 2006 meeting because we have used the time since that meeting to more thoroughly revise the ordinance to reflect the Council's desire to focus on protecting non-smokers from second-hand smoke rather than regulating smoking per se.

BACKGROUND:

At its meeting of January 18, 2006, Council discussed and introduced a motion to protect non-smokers from second-hand smoke in the City of Calabasas. The Council requested that Staff revise the ordinance to a) clarify the definition of outdoor areas; b) define signage requirements; and c) define smoking outpost sizes and location approval process. Further, Council requested staff to conduct additional outreach to hotels regarding non-smoking room ratios, and to bring back a campaign strategy to inform residents and visitors of the second-hand smoking control ordinance.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:

The ordinance modifications requested by Council and additional changes suggested by staff to clarify that this is a second-hand smoke control ordinance, and not a smoking control ordinance, are provided in the attached ordinance; the public information strategy and results of additional outreach will be provided as an oral report at the Council meeting.

FISCAL IMPACT/SOURCE OF FUNDING:

The ordinance will require the City to post new signage on City owned properties, and to prepare and disseminate materials related to a public awareness effort regarding the ordinance. The budget for these activities in FY06/07 is anticipated to be from \$5,000 to \$10,000 dependent upon Council's direction concerning the City's outreach effort.

REQUESTED ACTION:

Staff recommends that the City Council waive full reading and introduce revised Ordinance 2006-217 which regulates second hand smoke in the City of Calabasas.
