SUMMARY RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council approve staff's recommended motion to proclaim Saturday, April 1, 2006 as "Arbor Day" in the City of Calabasas.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:

Once annually, the City must both adopt an Arbor Day proclamation and hold an Arbor Day event to renew the City's TREE CITY, USA status. Attached is a resolution proclaiming Sunday, April 1, 2006 as Arbor Day. In honor of Arbor Day, the Environmental Commission recommends holding an Arbor Day celebration and tree-planting event at Headwaters Corner on Saturday, April 1, 2006.

Estimated costs of approximately \$1,000.00 will be used from the City's Urban Forestry Budget (Account No. 10-414-525055)
