PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Calabasas as AGENCY, invites sealed bids for the above stated project and will receive such bids in the office of the City Clerk, 100 Civic Center Way, Calabasas, California, 91302-3172 up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., on Tuesday, June 20, 2017. The bids will be publicly opened and read at 2:20 p.m. on June 20, 2017, in the Calabasas City Hall Council Chambers. All inquiries regarding the Sealed Bids shall be submitted, in email, to Mr. Benjamin Chan at [bchan@cityofcalabasas.com](mailto:bchan@cityofcalabasas.com) in the subject line, by 4:00 p.m. on June 16, 2017. There will not be an engineer's estimate provided for this project.

The Calabasas High School Access Improvement at Old Topanga Canyon Road project consists of widening the roadway to provide a merge lane, asphalt grinding and overlay, removal of sidewalk, construction of retaining curb, removal and construction of curb and gutter, signing, striping and other miscellaneous work as required by plans and specifications. Contractor shall diligently prosecute said work continuously and **must complete the project before the expiration 30 WORKING DAYS.** Project location: Thomas Guide 62nd Edition, page 559, Square G6.

Copies of the plans, specifications, and contract documents will be available starting Wednesday, June 7, 2017 from the City of Calabasas, 100 Civic Center Way, Calabasas, California 91302-3172 upon payment of a **\$40.00 non-refundable fee if picked up or if purchaser covers cost of postage, or payment of a \$55.00 non-refundable fee if mailed.** Bidders should contact Pauline Rubio-Brownell at (818) 224-1678, or by email at [pbrownell@cityofcalabasas.com](mailto:pbrownell@cityofcalabasas.com) with questions and requests for the bid documents.

In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code § 3300, and Business and Professions Code § 7028.15(e), the AGENCY has determined that the contractor shall possess a valid Class A contractor's license at the time that the contract is awarded. Prime contractor's sub-contractors shall possess all appropriate licenses in addition to complete work under City, County, State, and Federal guidelines. Failure to possess the specified license shall render a bidder's bid as non-responsive and shall bar award of the contract to any bidder not possessing the specified license at the time of the award.

**CONTRACTORS ARE REQUIRED BY LAW TO BE LICENSED AND REGULATED BY THE CONTRACTORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD. ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING A CONTRACTOR APRIL BE REFERRED TO THE REGISTRAR, CONTRACTORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD, P.O. BOX 2600, SACRAMENTO, CA 95826.** At the time the contract is awarded, the contractor shall be properly licensed in accordance with the laws of this state. The first payment for work or material shall not be made unless and until the Registrar of Contractors verifies to the AGENCY that the records of the Contractors' State License Board indicate that the contractor was properly licensed at the time the contract was awarded. Any bidder or contractor not so licensed shall be subject to all legal penalties imposed by law including, but not limited to, any appropriate disciplinary action by the Contractors' State Board. Failure of the bidder to obtain proper and adequate licensing for an award of a contract shall constitute a failure to execute the contract and shall result in the forfeiture of the security of the bidder. (Public Contract Code § 20103.5)

CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS FOR ANY BID PROPOSAL SUBMITTED ON OR AFTER MARCH 1, 2015, AND FOR ANY CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC WORK ENTERED INTO ON OR AFTER APRIL 1, 2015. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed on a bid proposal for, or perform any public work contract unless it is currently registered with the California Department of Industrial Relations as described in Labor Code § 1725.5.
