

NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS

LAS VIRGENES/THOUSAND OAKS ROUNDABOUT PROJECT SPECIFICATION NO. # 16-17-01 IN THE CITY OF CALABASAS, CALIFORNIA

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Calabasas as AGENCY, invites sealed bids for the above stated project and will receive such bids in the office of the City Clerk, 100 Civic Center Way, Calabasas, California, 91302-3172 up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., on Tuesday, June 20, 2017. The bids will be publicly opened and read at 2:10 p.m. on June 20, 2017, in the Calabasas City Hall Council Chambers. All inquiries regarding the Sealed Bids shall be submitted, in email, to Mr. Benjamin Chan at bchan@cityofcalabasas.com in the subject line, by 4:00 p.m. on June 16, 2017. An engineer's estimate is provided for this project.

The Las Virgenes Road Roundabout Project is located at the intersection of Las Virgenes Road and Thousand Oaks Boulevard, in the city of Calabasas. The project site is located mostly in residential zone. This intersection provides the only access to the Lupin Hill Elementary School. Therefore, traffic is heavy during drop offs in the morning and pick-ups in the afternoon after the summer recess and start of the 2017-18 School Year. More detailed discussions of this subject can be found in Sections E and F. The project to be constructed consists of construction of a roundabout, installation of landscaped planters and irrigation system, and raised median islands, minor excavation and earthwork, construction of lighting, installation of hardscape and aesthetic furniture, general electrical work, signing, striping and other miscellaneous work as required by plans and specifications. Contractor shall diligently prosecute said work continuously to completion before the expiration **60 WORKING DAYS**. Copies of the plans, specifications, and contract documents will be available starting Wednesday, June 7, 2017 from the City of Calabasas, 100 Civic Center Way, Calabasas, California 91302-3172 upon payment of a **\$40.00 non-refundable fee if picked up or if purchaser covers cost of postage, or payment of a \$55.00 non-refundable fee if mailed**. In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code § 3300, and Business and Professions Code § 7028.15(e), the AGENCY has determined that the contractor shall possess a valid Class A contractor's license at the time that the contract is awarded. Prime contractor's sub-contractors shall possess all appropriate licenses in addition to complete work under City, County, State, and Federal guidelines. Failure to possess the specified license shall render a bidder's bid as non-responsive and shall bar award of the contract to any bidder not possessing the specified license at the time of the award.

CONTRACTORS ARE REQUIRED BY LAW TO BE LICENSED AND REGULATED BY THE CONTRACTORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD. ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING A CONTRACTOR APRIL BE REFERRED TO THE REGISTRAR, CONTRACTORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD, P.O. BOX 2600, SACRAMENTO, CA 95826. At the time the contract is awarded, the contractor shall be properly licensed in accordance with the laws of this state. The first payment for work or material shall not be made unless and until the Registrar of Contractors verifies to the AGENCY that the records of the Contractors' State License Board indicate that the contractor was properly licensed at the time the contract was awarded. Any bidder or contractor not so licensed shall be subject to all legal penalties imposed by law including, but not limited to, any appropriate disciplinary action by the Contractors' State Board. Failure of the bidder to obtain proper and adequate licensing for an award of a contract shall constitute a failure to execute the contract and shall result in the forfeiture of the security of the bidder. (Public Contract Code § 20103.5)

CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS FOR ANY BID PROPOSAL
