

NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS

2017 STREET RESURFACING PROJECT SPECIFICATION NO. 16-17-02 IN THE CITY OF CALABASAS, CALIFORNIA

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Calabasas as AGENCY, invites sealed bids for the above stated project and **will receive such bids in the office of the City Clerk, 100 Civic Center Way, Calabasas, California, 91302-3172 up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., on Wednesday the 14th day of June, 2017. The bids will be publicly opened and read at 2:10 p.m. on the 14th day of June, 2017,** in the Calabasas City Hall Council Chambers. All inquiries regarding the Sealed Bids shall be submitted, in email, to Mr. Bryan Salguero at bsalguero@cityofcalabasas.com in the subject line, by 4:00 p.m. on June 7, 2017. There will not be an engineer's estimate provided for this project.

The 2017 STREET RESURFACING PROJECT to be constructed consists of the following streets:

1. Mulholland Hwy between Canyon Dr and the City Limits with the Los Angeles County.
2. Meadow Creek Rd between Las Virgenes Rd and Lost Hills Rd
3. Orchid Lane between Meadow Creek Rd and its Terminus
4. Park Miramar between Park Entrada and its Terminus

The project to be constructed consists of the CONTRACTOR furnishing all materials, equipment, tools, labor, and incidentals as required by the plans, specifications, and contract documents for the reconstruction or repair of Mulholland Hwy. The work includes: saw-cutting; excavation, removal and disposal of the AC roadway section; cold planing and disposal of AC pavement; replacement and compaction of subsurface material; setup and maintenance of temporary traffic control system; placement of crushed aggregate base and AC, and ARHM pavement materials; replacement of traffic striping and markings; and clean up of the project area. With the exception of Mulholland Hwy, the other three project areas borders residential homes; therefore, it is critical that noise and dust should be kept at a minimum during construction. Traffic control should be set up to allow for residents to access to their homes.

Bidder must be on the "Bid Holder List" to be eligible for bidding the 2017 Street Resurfacing Project, Specification 16-17-02. In order to be on the bid holder list, bidder is required to purchase copies of the plans, specifications, and contract documents from the City of Calabasas. Copies of the plans, specifications, and contract documents are available from the City of Calabasas, 100 Civic Center Way, Calabasas, California 91302-3172 upon payment of a **\$40.00 non-refundable fee if picked up or if purchaser covers cost of postage, or payment of a \$55.00 non-refundable fee if mailed.** Bidders should contact Pauline Rubio-Brownell at (818) 224-1678, or by email at pbrownell@cityofcalabasas.com with questions and requests for the bid documents.

In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code § 3300, and Business and Professions Code § 7028.15(e), the AGENCY has determined that the contractor shall possess a valid Class A contractor's license at the time that the contract is awarded. Prime contractor's sub-contractors shall possess all appropriate licenses in addition to complete work under City, County, State, and Federal guidelines. Failure to possess the specified license shall render a bidder's bid as non-responsive and shall bar award of the contract to any bidder not possessing the specified license at the time of the award.

CONTRACTORS ARE REQUIRED BY LAW TO BE LICENSED AND REGULATED BY THE CONTRACTORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD. ANY QUESTIONS CONCERNING A CONTRACTOR MAY BE REFERRED TO THE REGISTRAR, CONTRACTORS' STATE LICENSE BOARD, P.O. BOX

2600, SACRAMENTO, CA 95826. At the time the contract is awarded, the contractor shall be properly licensed in accordance with the laws of this state. The first payment for work or material shall not be made unless and until the Registrar of Contractors verifies to the AGENCY that the records of the Contractors' State License Board indicate that the contractor was properly licensed at the time the contract was awarded. Any bidder or contractor not so licensed shall be subject to all legal penalties imposed by law including, but not limited to, any appropriate disciplinary action by the Contractors' State Board. Failure of the bidder to obtain proper and adequate licensing for an award of a contract shall constitute a failure to execute the contract and shall result in the forfeiture of the security of the bidder. (Public Contract Code § 20103.5)

CONTRACTORS AND SUBCONTRACTORS ARE ALSO REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS FOR ANY BID PROPOSAL SUBMITTED ON OR AFTER MARCH 1, 2015, AND FOR ANY CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC WORK ENTERED INTO ON OR AFTER APRIL 1, 2015. A contractor or subcontractor shall not be qualified to bid on, be listed on a bid proposal for, or perform any public work contract unless it is currently registered with the California Department of Industrial Relations as described in Labor Code § 1725.5.

Bids must be prepared on the approved bid forms in conformance with INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS and submitted in the envelopes provided, sealed and plainly marked on the outside:

The bid must be accompanied by a bid guarantee in the amount of 10% of the total bid by 2:00 p.m. ON THE DATE ADVERTISED FOR THE OPENING OF BIDS. More specifically, pursuant to Public Contract Code §§ 20170 and 20171, all bids for the project shall be presented, under sealed cover and shall be accompanied by one of the following forms of bidder's security in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid: (a) cash; (b) a cashier's check made payable to the City of Calabasas; (c) a certified check made payable to the City of Calabasas; or (d) a bidder's bond executed by an admitted surety insurer, made payable to the City of Calabasas. Such security shall be forfeited should the successful bidder to whom the contract is awarded fails to timely execute the contract and to deliver the necessary bonds and insurance certificates as specified in the contract documents.

To the extent applicable, at any time during the term of the Agreement for the proposed project, the successful bidder may, at its own expense, substitute securities equivalent to the amount withheld as retention (or the retained percentage) in accordance with Public Contract Code § 22300.

Pursuant to California Civil Code § 9550, a payment bond is required to be submitted for all projects estimated in excess of \$25,000.00.

The AGENCY has determined that the proposed project is a public works subject to the provisions of Labor Code § 1720 thereby requiring the Contractor to pay the prevailing wage rates for all work performed under the Contract. Accordingly, the proposed project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the California Department of Industrial Relations.

The AGENCY reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
