Sales Tax Initiative Presentation

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Calabasas Community Foundation Board Members receive this report for file.

**BACKGROUND**

At the October 6, 2025 Study Session, City Council directed staff to proceed with community outreach regarding a potential sales tax initiative.

**DISCUSSION**

As part of that outreach, presentations are being conducted at various community and civic meetings. The City also contracted with FM3 Research to conduct a statistically valid survey to identify resident priority issues and gauge voter sentiment regarding a potential sales tax measure, including a second survey conducted in November 2025. FM3 presented the survey results at the December 3, 2025 City Council meeting, and City Council voted to place the sales tax initiative on the November ballot.
