**NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION
FOR A BALLOT MEASURE
TO BE VOTED ON**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Pursuant to Section 12111 of the Elections Code of the State of California, that the following measure will be voted on by all-mail ballot at the Special Municipal Election to be held in the City of Calabasas on **Tuesday, the 5th day of May 2026**:

<p>Calabasas Public Safety/City Services Measure: To maintain Calabasas' financial stability and general City services, such as preparing for/responding to wildfires; reduce fire risk by managing brush/other fuels/natural areas; maintain 911/Sheriff response; help prevent property crimes/thefts/burglaries; keep public areas safe/clean; repairing streets; shall a measure establishing a 1¢ sales tax providing approximately \$5,300,000 annually until ended by voters; requiring audits, spending disclosure, all funds locally controlled, be adopted?</p>	YES

Ballots will be mailed to all City of Calabasas registered voters. Voters shall cast their vote and return to the Elections Official (City Clerk) via mail, or by delivering it to the Calabasas City Hall.

Mail ballots postmarked or date stamped by bona fide mail delivery on or before election day on **Tuesday, May 5, 2026**, will be counted, if it is received by the Elections Official in accordance with the California Elections Code. Ballots may be returned by mail in the **postage-paid yellow envelopes** provided with the ballot.


