

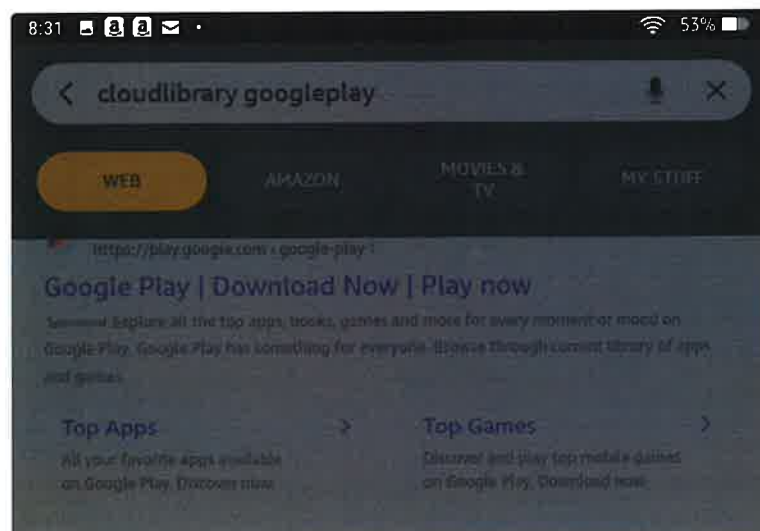
Apps - Fire Download for OS 5-7

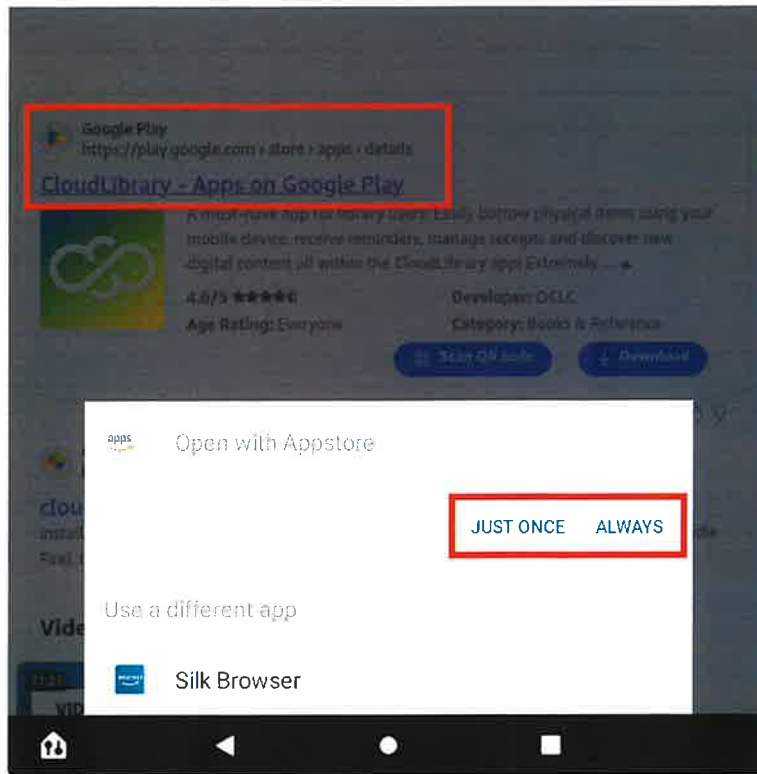
Patrons with Fire OS versions lower than 8 may not see the CloudLibrary app display when searched in the Amazon Appstore. This article provides steps for users with Fire OS 5-7 to **download** or **reinstall** CloudLibrary.

Note: Patrons with OS 8 or later can download the app from the Amazon Appstore using these instructions: [Apps - Fire Download from Amazon AppStore](#) .

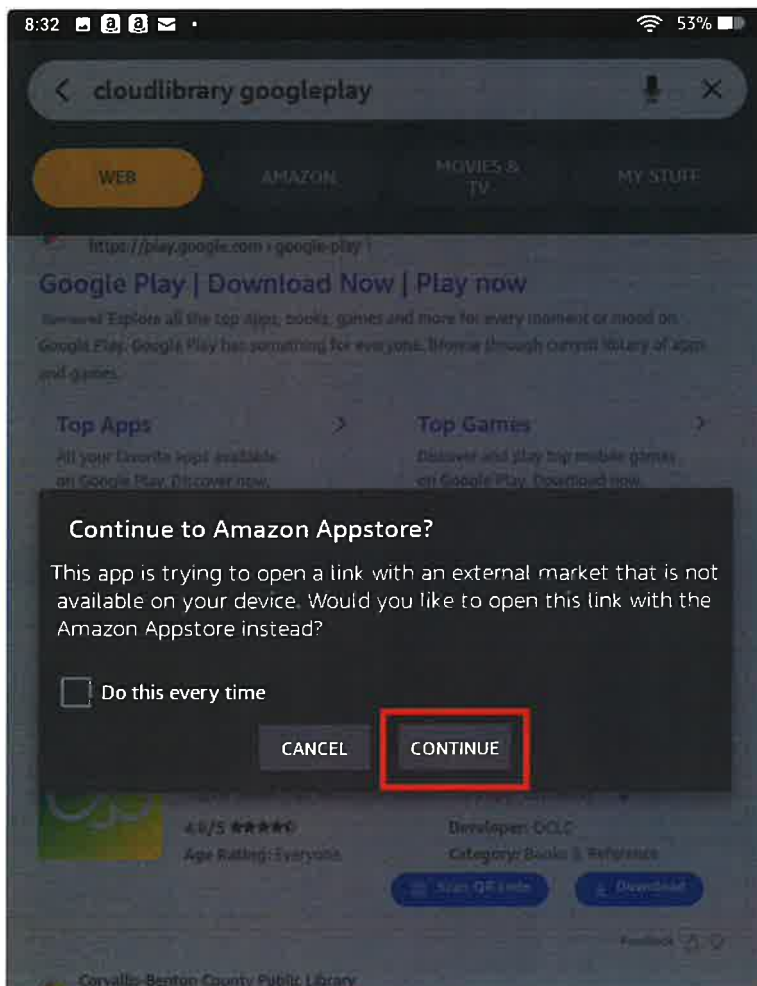
Download Instructions

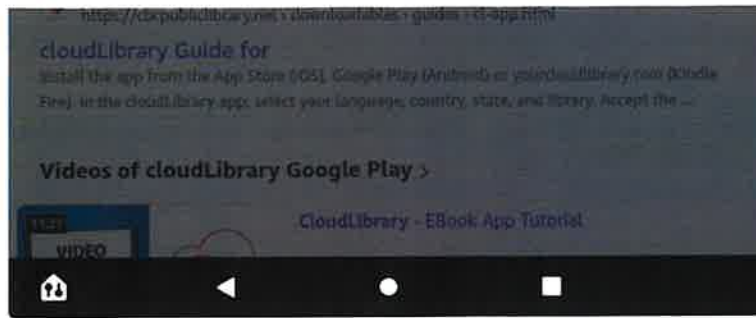
1. Navigate to the Home Screen on your Fire.
2. Type "**CloudLibrary Google Play**" into the Search Bar. This will open a search on your Silk Browser.
3. Tap the Google Play link to the Cloud Library app (**CloudLibrary - Apps on Google Play**).
4. A popup will ask if you would like to open the app in the Appstore instead. Tap **Just Once** or **Always**.





5. An additional message will popup to confirm continuing to the Amazon Appstore. Tap **Continue**.



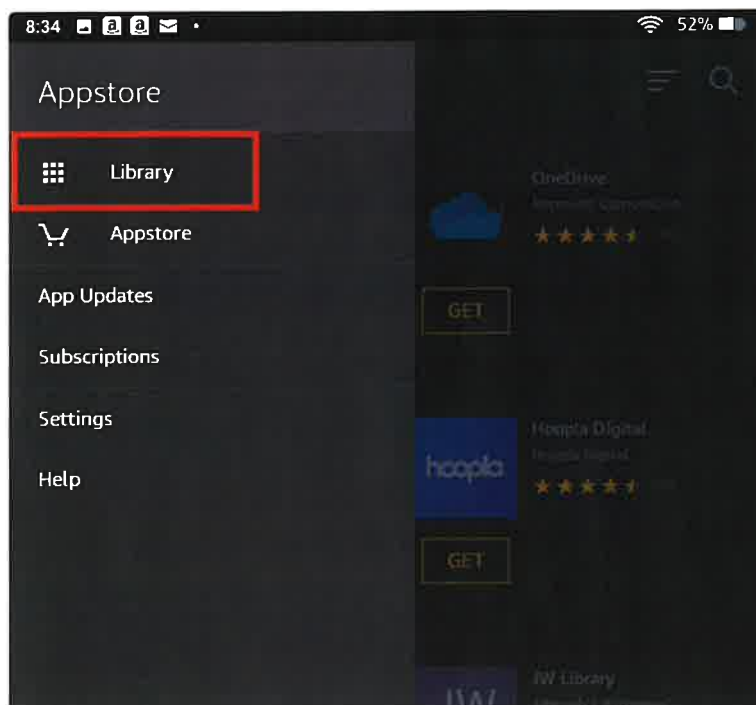


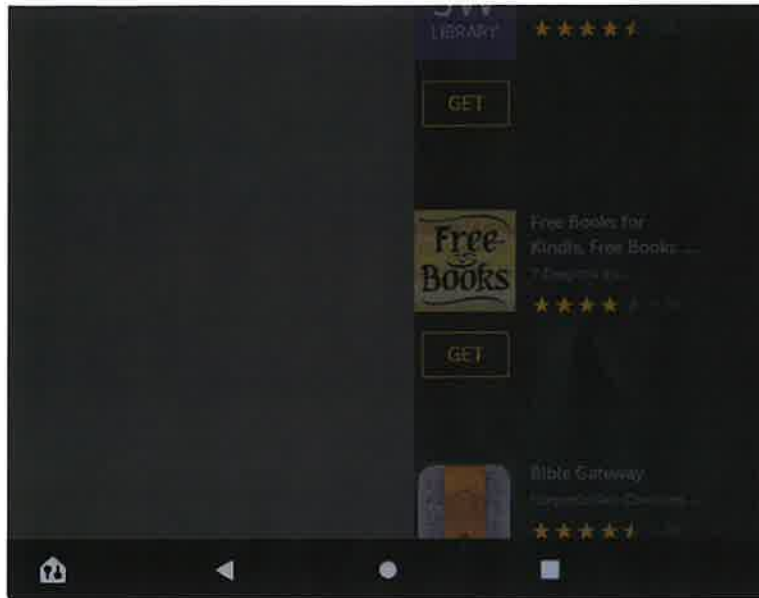
6. This will continue to bring you to the CloudLibrary app page in the Appstore. Tap **Download**.

Reinstall Instructions

If a patron has previously downloaded the CloudLibrary app on their Fire device and wishes to reinstall the app, they can do so using the following steps:

1. Tap the **Amazon Appstore** app.
2. Tap the 3 horizontal lines in the top left corner to open the sidebar menu. Tap **Library**.





3. Locate the CloudLibrary app. Tap the **Download** button next to it to reinstall the app onto the device.
